## Re-examination of 24th BCS exam demanded

Different student organisations continued agitation on Sunday to realise the three points demand including postponement and re-examination of the 24th BCS preliminary examination.

They also demanded resignation of the Chairman of Public Service Commission (PSC) immediately taking responsibility for leaking out the question papers. The student organisations held rallies and brought out processions on the Dhaka University campus in support of their demands. The students vowed to continue the agitation for an unidentified period if their demands are not met immediately.

The question papers of the preliminary tests of 24th Bangladesh Civil Service (BCS) reportedly leaked out on Thursday, a day before the examinations. The one-hour examination was held from 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm on Friday.

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) held a rally in front of Arts Building in support of Tuesday's strike. BCL called the strike on March 4 (Tuesday) in all the educational institutions the country protesting the leaking out of the BCS question papers.
