SSC exams begin tomorrow

Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination under seven education boards begins across the country from Thursday, reports BSS.

A total of 9,33,652 candidates including 4,15,035 female students will appear in the examinations this year.

Simultaneously, Dakhil examinations under Bangladesh Madrasa Education Board and SSC (vocational) examinations under Bangladesh Technical Education Board will also begin on Thursday.

In the Dakhil examinations a total of 1,68,769 students including 64,407 female candidates will appear while 31,628 students including 9,964 female students will sit for SSC (vocational) examinations.

About 846 centers have been set up for SSC exams, 395 centers for Dakhil exams and 415 centers for SSC (vocational) exams.

The highest number, 2,73,224 students will appear from Rajshahi Education Board followed by Dhaka Board 2,72,577. The number of candidates in other five education boards are: Comilla 1,06,395, Jessore 1,06,303, Chittagong 68,999, Barisal 63,536 and Sylhet 30,616.

The Education Ministry has taken all preparations for holding the examination in an atmosphere free from unfair means. In view of this, special measures were taken to check cheating in vulnerable centers.
