1,229 HSC examinees expelled on first day

At least 1,229 examinees were expelled on the first day of HSC. Alim, Fazil examinations under nine Education Boards for adopting unfair means, reports UNB.

English 1st paper examination of HSC was held on Thursday. Some 5,30,330 students are appearing in HSC examinations.

Highest 369 examinees were expelled from centres under the Rajshahi Education Board.

Control Room sources said 127 examinees were expelled from centres under the Dhaka Board, 59

of Jessore Board, 83 of Chittagong Board, 50 of Comilla Board, 74 of Barisal Board and 25 of Sylhet Education Board.

The Madrasa Education Board control room sources said 272 Alim and Fazil examinees were expelled from 149 centres.

Technical Education Board control room said 170 examinees were expelled from 220 centres.

Education Minister Dr. M. Osman Faruk on Thursday visited some centres in the city but he (See Page 15 Col 6)
