

## RU students protest PSC decision, call hartal tomorrow

RAJSHAHI, May 12:—Hundreds of agitated students of RU put barricade on Dhaka highway at noon of Monday to protest the decision of Public Service Commission.

In a recent move PSC has set rule to have minimum 45 per cent mark in Bangla and English to sit for 25<sup>th</sup> BCS Examinations, they informed.

During the barricade hundreds of vehicle got stranded on both the side of the highway. The barricade was withdrawn after an hour at the request of proctor.

Earlier students brought out several procession on the campus and after barricading the road they organised a meeting on the campus which was addressed, among others, by Rezaul Karim, Zakaria, Biswajit and Abu Sayeed.

As a further measure of their action programme they called full day strike in Rajshahi University on 14<sup>th</sup> May to register their anger. Earlier agitated students formed a Sangram Parishad with Rezaul Karim as Convenor.

On Saturday evening students also brought out procession and observed sit-in-protest in front of Vice Chancellor for an hour.
