## 'Policy on pvt educational instt changed'

The government has changed the policy to set up private educational institution named after a person. Education Minister Dr Osman Faruq told the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday replying to a question from Mirza Ajam (AL).

The policy provides for placing money in the reserved fund of the institution. The fund would be run under the joint signature of the head of the institution or president of the governing body and district education officer.

The money would be spent for the development of the institution.

For withdrawal of money, approval of the director general of the directorate of the secondary and higher education will be needed.

Besides, there had been changes in principles for appointment of the president of the governing body of private schools and intermediate colleges.

The policy provides for nomination of chairman of the governing body from among local MP, deputy commissioner, retired government official, local eminent educationist and local social worker.

If an MP wants to be chairman of an institution in his area, he should submit a proposal to the

education minister through the minister-in-charge of the area.

If the MP is unwilling to be chairman he may propose a name for the chairman from among retired official, local eminent educationist and local social worker through the minister-in-charge of the area to the education minister, he said.
