

**Prof Sirajul Huq  
awarded Ahsanullah  
Gold Medal**

Prof. Emeritus Dr. Sirajul Huq has been nominated for the award of Khanbahadur Ahsanullah Gold Medal 2002 for his life long contributions in the field of education and research. The Gold medal will be formally awarded to him in a function to be held on May 4 at 4-30 pm in the auditorium of Dhaka Ahsania Mission in Dhanmondi.

Established in the name of the noted educationist, social reformer and religious mentor of the subcontinent and founder of Dhaka Ahsania Mission, Khanbahadur Ahsanullah, the Gold Medal is being awarded since 1986 to persons having remarkable contributions in the field of education and social service.

Dr. Sirajul Huq was born on 1 April in village Volakot, under Ramganj thana of Laksmipur district. His father was Moulvi Hamidullah. He obtained BA (Hons) and MA degree in Islamic Studies, and MA degree in Persian from Dhaka University. He got his Ph.D. from University of London in 1937.
