## JCD drives out BCL leaders from RUET campus

RAJSHAHI, July 29:—JCD cadres in a sudden and desperate attack injured 15 BCL members at RUET during early hours of Thursday. Of which eight were admitted to clinics. Later on JCD cadres driven BCL leaders out of RUET campus. In another incident JCD cadres beaten up one Section Officer and office assistant of RU Controller of Examination office on Thursday.

RUET authority has not taken any step to cool down situation or tried to prevent JCD from unruly action, as alleged by BCL. It is reported, during early hours of Thursday 30/35 armed cadres of JCD including outsiders led by organising secretary of RUET JCD turned up at room no. 313 of Hamid Hall. After pulling up BCL leader Asif as asked him whether there was any arms and instantly ransacked the the room. Afterwards they made operation in all the four halls of RUET and pulled BCL leaders and lined up in tennis ground. They were beaten up with rod, lathi, and

ramdao and lethal weapons. Later on they were (BCL) driven out of the campus saying, they would have to seek permission of JCD.

BCL leaders tried to contact RUET VC and hall provosts but failed. During Thursday BCL has lodged complain with RUET VC Prof. Anwarul Huq and high officials but no step was taken, as alleged by BCL.

They were still remaining out of campus. No case was filed with police. In RU incident, JCD leader Ariful Huq Ripon went to controller section with 125 Taka DD to withdraw his Honours mark sheet immediately. Controller office assistant asked him to deposit further 100 taka as urgent fee. Later infuriated JCD cadre Ripon alongwith others beaten up office assistant Alimul Reza. Section Officer Manjur Morshed was also beaten up. Later on Pro VC Mamunul Keramat was informed by CEO high official.
