

25 hurt in fierce clash

9 DU JCD leaders expelled

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), the student wing of ruling BNP, on Sunday expelled its nine leaders and activists of Dhaka University for their alleged involvement in "anti-organisational" activities, reports UNB.

Senior JCD leaders took the decision following two violent incidents in Jagannath and Jasimuddin halls on Saturday.

The expelled JCD leaders of Ja-

simuddin Hall are Delwar, Jafar Ahmed, Mamun, Rumel, Kutubuddin, Mainul Islam while the leaders of Jagannath Hall are Kirit Majumdar, vice-president of the hall JCD unit, and Sabuj Biswas.

Besides, the post of Organising Secretary of JCD's Jasimuddin hall unit, held by Munir, has been made non-functional.

Meanwhile, Joint Secretary MA Tuhin ar and Helaluddin have been

issued show-cause notices asking them to explain their involvement in Saturday's violence incidents.

On the day, a fierce clash between two groups of JCD's Jasimuddin Hall Unit left at least 25 injured and over 50 rooms ransacked.

In Jagannath Hall, JCD activists attacked a programme of the hall employees for not inviting them to the function.
