

Fazilatunnesa Hall incident

DUTA for exemplary punishment to students

Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) on Friday demanded the Dhaka University authority to give exemplary punishment to the students of Begum Fazilatunnesa Hall who misbehaved with the provost and house tutors.

Making the demand at an emergency meeting the DUTA said that if the demand for punishment was not met by 72 hours

it would announce a tougher programme.

Condemning the misbehaviour of students with the provost and house tutors and the "anarchic situation" at the hall, the DUTA expressed its solidarity with the stance of provost and house tutors.

Presided over the DUTA Presi-

dent Dr AAMS Arefin Siddiqui, the meeting demanded the university authority to request the provost and house tutors to join their posts instead of accepting their resignation letters.

The meeting observed that there might be a conspiracy behind the incident and urged the university authority to find out the conspirators and expose them to the nation.

The meeting urged the university authority to inform guardians for the misbehaviour of their daughters or wards with the teachers.

The meeting also expressed its concern over the delay in taking actions against the students involved in the incident.
