NU degree results published

Results of Degree (pass), Degree (pass) 1st year, Subsidiary and Certificate Course examinations of 2004 under National University (NU) were published on Wednesday with a pass percentage of 50.39, says UNB.

A total of 18,851 students appeared at the traditional two-year degree course while 36,306 sat for the newly introduced three-year degree (pass) course examinations.

The pass percentage of the traditional two-year degree course is 37.46 while that of the three-year degree (pass) course is 48.27.

A total of 535 students secured first division, 16,163 obtained second division and 7,571 got third division from both the two and three years' degree courses.

Besides, 44,345 out of 48,809 students became successful in the first year degree (pass) examination. The pass percentage is 90.85.

A total of 20,671 students appeared at the subsidiary examination and of them 11,544 came out successful.

only 514 emerged successful.

National University Vice Chancellor Prof Dr Aftab Ahmed formally announced the results at the NU conference room this noon.

VC Dr Aftab Ahmed told reporters that the results of 700 students remained withheld as the answer-scripts of their practical exams did not reach the university while that of 200 others for mistakes in the answer-scripts and MR sheets.

Results of the rest 84 students were shown withheld as the authorities found their answer-scripts tampered by some dishonest officials, the NU VC said.
