## 60 BAU teachers working outside varsity: Study of students hampered

AGRI-VARSITY, (Mymensingh) May 29:—The academic activities in the Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU) are being hampered due and officers of the university in other educational institutions and NGOs violating the regulations of the university which does not allow teachers and officers to involve in other organizations.

According to rules the teachers and officers of the university must obtain permission to work elsewhere and deposit a certain amount of earnings to the university.

The rule was set to discourage the teachers and officers from engaging themselves elsewhere. But more than 60 teachers and officers of the university are taking classes in college or coaching

centres and discharging the duty of consultants in NGOs have not obtained permission from the Vice-Chancellor.

The teachers who engaged in different educational institutions are quite irregular in taking their classes and performing their examinations related duty in the university.

The malpractices by a section of teachers is an open secret. No action has been taken against any of them by the university authority.

The teachers and officers working with the organisations defended themselves saying that they took job in other organisations for extra income as the salaries provided by the university were not enough for them.
