

HSC exams begin from May 12

A total of 4,70,526 male and female candidates will appear at the Secondary School Certificate (HSC), Alim and Business Management Examinations in 1,324 centres of the country, on Thursday.

The examination will begin under nine education boards from May 12.

Under Dhaka Board, 1,33,690

male and female candidates will appear in the HSC examination in 259 centres. Of them, 74,849 are male and 58,841 are female.

Under Rajshahi Board, 1,05,743 male and female candidates will appear in the HSC examination in 268 centres. Of them, 63,066 are male and 42,677 are female.

Under Comilla Board, 34,630

candidates will appear in the HSC examination in 113 centres. Of them, 20,507 are male and 14,123 are female.

Under Jessore Board, 70,066 candidates will appear in the forthcoming HSC examination in 138 centres. Of them, 41,425 are male and 28,641 are female.

Under Chittagong Board, 33,174 candidates will appear in the HSC examination in 79 centres. Of the total, 18,521 are male and the rest 14,653 are female.

Under Barisal Board, 27,766 students will appear in the HSC examination in 80 centres. Of them, 15,871 are male and the rest 11,895 are female.

Under Sylhet Board, 17,405 examinees will participate in the upcoming HSC examination in 54 centres. Of them, 9,134 are male and the rest 8,271 are female.

Under Madrasah Board, 48,052 students will appear in the Alim examination in 333 centres. Of the total, 35,403 are male and the rest 12,649 are female.

The information of number of students and number of centres under Technical Board was not available.
