Khulna Varsity foundation laid

KHULNA, Mar. 9.—President Hussain Muhammad Ershad today laid the foundation stone of Khulna University at Gollamari, about five kilometres from here, saying that the journey that had been started from the venue of the University in the educational and social life would remain a pathfinder for the nation for the coming days, reports BSS.

He said we had not merely laid the foundation stone of a University today but also established a meeting place for the humanity. "Our journey would take us to our desired goal and it is our united responsibility to achieve this great objective," he pointed out.

President Ershad formally laid the foundation stone of Khulna University amidst fanfare while hundreds of thousands of people spontaneously gathered there cheering him with thunderous applauses and welcome slogans.


