## CU reopens today

CHITTAGONG, Jan 15: Chittagong University (CU) goes back to academic and administrative operations from tomorrow (Tuesday) after a 21-day unscheduled closure.

The university went on an indefinite closure on December 26 last year following a planned attack on the supporters of Chhatra League (BCL) and the left leaning student fronts by the cadres of the Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS).

According to the academic calendar the university was scheduled to go on Eid vacation on December 30 last year. Majority of the students have not yet back to their dormitories fearing clashes between the rivals.

Sources watching the campus keenly feared fresh clash on the campus out of the retaliatory attacks by the supporters and well-wishers of the oppressed students.

Sources said that the cadres of the CU unit of ICS are learnt to have taken preparation with arms for ousting the BCL workers from the campus. On the other hand, the BCL did not finalize the outline of the movement it might launch from the opening day.

The BCL leaders are confused about the next course of action program mainly in the face of ongoing state emergency in the country.

A three-member probe committee headed by Professor Anisul Islam was formed to investigate the incident of December 24. But the committee did not start the investigation on the incident after passing 21 days.
