

Students' violence

2 detained DU teachers give deposition to Commission.

The Judicial Inquiry Commission formed to investigate into August 20-22 violences in and around Dhaka University took deposition of detained two DU teachers and the President of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) on the second day on Monday.

Member of the working Council of DUTA and the Dean of the Social Science Faculty Prof. Harunor-Rashid and Chairman of the Department of Applied Physics Science and Provost of Jagannath Hall Prof. Nimchandra Bhawnik gave deposition to the Commission at the Central Circuit House.

The Commission also took deposition of the JCD President Azizul Bari Tital who arrested on charge of instigating students in campus turmoil.

The Chief of the one-member Commission Justice Habibur Rahman Khan said that we took deposition from the teachers in

the interest of investigation. Necessary information would be found through their deposition, he said.

Habibur Rahman Khan said that he would to the eminent educationists, lawyers and member of the civil society after taking deposition of the DU teachers.

General Secretary of the Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) and Dean of the Biological Science Faculty Prof. Dr. Anwar Hossain and DUTA President Prof. Sadrul Amin give their statement about the incidents to the Commission.

According to sources, the deposition process of detained DU unit President of Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) Manabendra Dev has also started. Law enforcers arrested him in connection with provocation of student violence.

It may be noted that the one-member probe committee was formed on August 25 to investigate the violence of the DU campus. The Commission was given 15 working days to submit its report. Later, the time-frame was extended by another 20 days. The Commission has so far recorded statements of 86 persons.
