## DU to send letter to govt seeking sympathetic behavior with arrested teachers

The Dhaka University Syndicate on Tuesday decided to send a letter to the government seeking "sympathetic behavior" with the DU teachers and students arrested following the recent campus violence, reports UNI.

The DU syndicate took the decision at a meeting with Vice-Chancellor Prof Dr SMA Faiz in the chair.

Four DU professors—Dr Harun-ur-Rashid, Dr Anwar Hossain, Dr Sadrol

Amin and Dr Neem Chandra Bhounik—are now in jail. They were arrested on charge of provoking student unrest on the campus on August 20-22, leading the university to a 3-month closure.

The DU syndicate also accepted a report of a university probe committee, headed by pro-VC Prof AFM Yusuf Haider. The committee was formed following the killing of Prof Dr Atab Ahmed at his campus residence on Sep-

tember 25 last year.

Sources said the committee in its report recommended the DU syndicate to consider forming campus police and providing modern training to the university security guards to ensure security of the teachers and students on the campus.
