Legal actions against fake students under process : DUVC

The investigation committee of Dhaka University (DU) formed to find out the fake students has decided to take legal action against 22 students who were admitted to the university through illegal means.

Vice-chancellor of DU Prof. S M A Faiz disclosed on Tuesday that the names of the fake students were sent to law enforcing agencies for taking legal actions.

"We got many information about fake admission and we would continue our investigation until the fake students were evicted from the university," he added.

Earlier, the probe body detected 33 more fake students in different departments including Economics, Public Administration and International Relations in 2004-2005 session and now the total number of fake students stands at 55.

The investigation committee has found the presence of fake students at DU who managed illegal admissions in connivance with unauthorised coaching centres. To mention, these so-called coaching centres

are allegedly involved in leaking out question papers while the partisan students helped them go unabated.

The probe committee has primarily suspended two DU officials on charge of involvement in processing illegal admissions. The suspended officials registrar are Deputy Register of the University A K M Mozammel Hossain and Staff of Public Administration Department Yunus Akandh.

The committee has issued letters to the fake students asking them to submit their genuine admission documents within 15 days.

Meanwhile, the fake students residing in different residential halls, especially Jashimuddin hall, have started leaving the dormitories.
