Fake admission in DU

Probe body formed to identify real culprits

The Dhaka University (DU) authorities have finally formed a five-member investigation committee to identify the those involved in the malpractice in the sensational fake admission process in the university.

Headed by eminent columnist Sadek Khan the committee has been tasked with conducting in-depth investigation into the scandal that has tarnished the image of the university.

The other members of the committee are Prof. Anwar Hossain, Dean of Biological

Science Faculty, Prof. Dr. Borhan Uddin Khan, Dean of Law Faculty, Shamsuzzaman Duru, Former MP and Prof. Sadeka Halim, Syndicate member.

Meanwhile, DU authorities have cancelled the admission of 77 students in different departments and institutes on charge of forgery. The probe committee earlier found their admission process fake.

The DU authorities handed

over a list of fake students to the law enforcing agencies and asked them to nab the accused students if seen anywhere on the campus.

On the other hand, the probe committee did not find any proof of question paper leakage. The allegation of question paper leakage was raised involving "much talked" about 52 successors who secured first class in the Political Science department.
