

## Requests for arrested teachers' division DU Syndicate team discusses university situation with CA

A delegation of Dhaka University Syndicate headed by the vice-chancellor on Sunday met Chief Advisor Dr Fakhruddin Ahmed and discussed with him overall situation of the varsity shut down amid a turmoil, reports UNB.

Army Chief General Moeen U Ahmed and Education Advisor Ayub Quadri were present at the meeting held at the CA office in the afternoon.

They requested the head of caretaker government to take

steps for providing division to the detained DU professors in jail.

Three teachers of the university are now in jail following cases filed on charges of provoking the students into breaking the emergency rules during the August 20-22 student unrest on the campus.

There was a very important meeting with the Chief Advisor. We have requested the CA to ensure getting division by the DU teachers. We also requested him

to ensure 'sympathetic' behavior with the arrested students," DU Vice-chancellor Prof. Dr SMA Faiz told reporters after the meeting.

Prof. Faiz said there was also discussion about the overall campus situation and the reopening of the university.

Three DU professors - Dr Sadrul Amin and Dr Anwar Hossain, respectively president and general secretary of Dhaka University Teachers' Association, and Dr Harun-or-Rashid, Dean of Social Sciences Faculties - are now in jail.

Dr Sadrul Amin was sent to jail after he surrendered in a court today. Another DU professor, Dr Nim Chandra Bhoumic, provost of Jagannath Hall who was also charged with the arrested teachers, has been absconding since the filing of the case.
