Public entry within 200 yards of centres banned SSC exam begins today amid tight security

The Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and its equivalent Dakhil examinations under nine education boards begin countrywide today (Thursday) amid stern security.

This year's a total of 10,29,885 examinees will appear in the examinations.

About 243 examinees will appear at the SSC examination in seven overseas centres in Jeddah and Riyadh in Saudi Arab, Abu Dhabi in the United Arab Emirates, Tripoli in Libya, Doha in

Qatar, Dubai and Manama.

All the nine education boards including Madrasha and Technical education boards took necessary measures for holding the exam in a fair from the menace of copying.

Meanwhile, Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) has announced a ban on public entry within 200 yards of the centres in the city for SSC and its equivalent examination.

Adjacent area within 200 yards of the examination centres has

been banned to unwanted people for ensuring congenial atmosphere in the centres. It was announced by Metropolitan Police Commissioner Nayeem Ahmed.

This year a total of 10,29,885 examinees will appear in the examinations. Of them, 7,96,073 are under seven secondary and higher education boards, 1,69,387 under Madrasha Education Board and 64,425 under the Bangladesh Technical Board.
