CHITTAGONG, Nov 4:—University Grants Commission (UGC) is likely to take initiatives to solve the crisis regarding unplanned hiring of faculties took place at different public universities soon. Vice-Chancellors and officials concerned of different public uni-

versities including Chittagong University (CU) and Rajshahi University (RU) joined separate negotiation meetings with the UGC recently in this regard.

Sources close to the UGC said that they wanted to know the causes behind the additional hiring beyond its knowledge from the VCs of the public universities.

Vice-Chancellor of Chittagong University Professor M Bodiul Alam and three other high officials accompanying him reportedly had to explain the grounds of the illegal hiring of 108 employees.

Former Vice-Chancellor of the university Professor AJM Nuruddin Chowdhury and his successor Professor M Bodiul Alam made the hiring between July 2005 and December 2006 allegedly keeping the UGC in total dark.

Sources said that the unplanned hiring mostly based on political bias put the university into tremendous financial crisis for more than two years now.

Senior Accounts Officer of the university said that a smart amount of deficit caused from the unplanned hiring had long been forcing the authorities to carry forward the amount with a hope that the grant commission would ultimately address it.
