UGC to probe CU certificate scam, other irregularities

The University Grants Commission (UGC) on Tuesday formed a committee headed by its member Prof Sultan Hussain to probe into various irregularities at Chittagong University (CU) including the LLB

Certificate scam, a UGC press release said.

The committee is to submit its report within 15 days from the date of its formation. It will investigate complaints relating to irregular appointments and other irregularities at the university, the Syndicate resolution relating to the LLB exam scam and the related probe committee reports, documents, papers, exam result-sheets, exam scripts and other relevant papers, the release added.

Meanwhile, the CU authorities yesterday started sending letters to the cancelled LLB certificate holders at their personal addresses.

Other members of the committee are UGC members Prof M Tareque Shamsur Rahman, Prof Ehsanul Haque and Dhaka University Controller of Examination M Baharul Haque Chowdhury, the release said.

Prof M Muzaffar Hossain, acting examination controller of the CU, said other actions against the certificate scam such as sending related documents of the persons concerned to Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) would start soon.

Process of publishing a gazette notification of the cancelled certificates of Degree (pass), Subsidiary and B-Ed is also going on, he added.

Sources said the university authorities earlier sent the list of 50 cancelled LLB certificate holders to Chancellor of the university, Bar Council chairman in Dhaka and the law colleges concerned all over the country.

On Saturday, the authorities published a gazette notification cancelling LLB certificates of 50 examinees including that of controversial judge Faisal Mahmud Faizee on charge of tampering with their tabulation sheets and other irregularities.
