Scholarship Fair begins

A four-day Scholarship and Discount Admission Fair 2007 began at Bashundhara City in the city yesterday.

Fifteen public universities of the country and 50 international universities from 12 countries are participating in the fair along with different training institutes and education loan providers.

In the fair, around Tk 3.5 crore will be offered to meritorious but financially insolvent students as scholarships.

Dhaka University Vice Chancellor (VC) Prof SMA Faiz inaugurated the fair, also attended by World University of Bangladesh VC Prof Dr Abdul Mannan Chowdhury and Daffodil Group Chairman M Sabur Khan.

In the inaugural session, three financially insolvent but bright students who achieved GPA-5 in HSC examination -- Mubashwer Uddin Ahmed from Dhaka board, Shamirna Akhtar from Jessore board and M Rezaul Karim from Rajshahi board--- were awarded scholarships.
