Indefinite strike at DU from today if demands not met

Announcing a five-point demand, including immediate withdrawal of Police and Army men from the DU campus, exemplary punishment to the attackers of students and teachers and the State of Emergency, the general students called an indefinite strike at Dhaka University from today (Wednesday) and one day strike in all the educational institutions across the country today (Wednesday).

At a news conference held at Madhu's Canteen in the evening on Tuesday, they announced their programme. The other two demands included providing treat-

ment charges and compensation to the injured students and unconditional release of the arrested students.

They warned that if the demands were not met within next 24 hours, a general strike would be called in all the educational institutions across the country.

They said the half-educated constables of Police and Army should not be allowed to enter the university campuses. They deplored that it was humiliating that police non-qualified Police and Army men are deployed to check the university students.

The other programmes included holding of solidarity meeting and mass hearing today (Wednesday) at the foot of Apurajaya Bangla at 10:00 am. The rally and demonstration will for an indefinite period.
