Govt fixes dates for SSC, HSC exams

The government has fixed the dates for holding examinations and publishing the results of Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations from the year of 2010, said an Education Ministry handout on Tuesday, reports BSS.

According to the handout, SSC and equivalent examinations will be held on February 1 and HSC and equivalent examinations on April 1 in every year from 2010.

The results of SSC and equivalent examinations would be published on May 10, and HSC and equivalent examinations on July 10, the handout added.

Dates for all the examinations in next two years - 2008 and 2009 - have also been fixed. SSC and equivalent examinations will begin on February 28 in 2008 and on February 15 in 2009 while HSC and equivalent examinations will

be held on April 29 and April 15 respectively, the handout said.

Results of SSC and equivalent examinations will be published on June 8 in 2008 and on May 25 in 2009 while the results of HSC and equivalent will be published on August 10 and July 25 respectively, the handout added.

The circular said in case of failure to hold the examinations on the fixed date due to unavoidable reasons, the same will be held on the next day or any earliest possible dates.

The public examinations would also be completed within shortest possible time keeping in mind not to create extra pressure on the examinees, the handout said.
