

Biswas sworn in as President

Mr Abdur Rahman Biswas was sworn in as the President of Bangladesh Wednesday afternoon at a simple but impressive function held at the Darbar Hall of Bangabhaban.

Acting Chief Justice of Bangladesh Mr Justice Habibur Rahman administered the oath of office to the newly-elected President who will be a titular Head of State, under the present parliamentary system of government.

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia, former Presidents Mr Justice A.M. Sayem, Mr Justice Ahsanuddin and Mr Mohammadullah, Ministers, Judges, Members of Parliament, Chief of Army Staff, Chief of Naval Staff, and Chief of Air Staff, leaders of different political parties including Abbas Ali Khan and Maulana Matiur Rahman Nizami MP of Jamaat-e-Islami, Mr Salahuddin Kader Chowdhury MP of NDP, Mr Rashed Khan Menon MP of Workers Party, Mr Shahjahan Siraj MP of JSD (Siraj) and Mr Hasanul Huq Inu of JSD (Inu), diplomats and high civil and military officials were present.

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia greeted President Biswas soon after his swearing-in. The President also exchange greetings with dignitaries present after the brief ceremony.

Former Acting President Mr Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed was not seen at the function.

None from Awami League, Jatiya Party and CPB were present. Awami League and Jatiya Party also did not attend the swear-in ceremony of the cabinet led by Begum Khaleda Zia.

Immediately after the swear-in ceremony, President Abdur Rahman Biswas was given a Guard of Honour by a smartly turned out contingent of President's Guard Regiment.
