## Rabita Secy-Gen apprises Biswas of Darul Ihsan Varsity

The visiting Secretary General of the Makkah Based Rabita Al Alam Al Islami Dr Abdullah Omar Nasseef on Friday called on President Abdur Rahman Biswas at Bangabhaban, reports BSS.

The Rabita Secretary General apprised the President of the Darul Ihsan University being set up at Savar which would be the seat of learning and high level research work needed for the Muslim Ummah. He also informed the President that Rabita would provide more fund to the reconstruction and rehabilitation of Rabita Hospitals at Chittagong damaged during April's tidal surge. The Rabita would also provide more assistance in the rehabilitation of the cyclone victims in different coastal areas.
