

## Bad performance in last exams is the reason Recognition of 27 schools, 5 colleges cancelled in Jessore

JESSORE, July 20.—The recognition of twenty seven secondary schools and five colleges under Jessore Board of Secondary and Intermediate has been cancelled due to their bad performances during the last public examinations.

It may be mentioned here that the Board had earlier issued show-cause notices to those institutions which failed to achieve 5% Pass Percentage. As they failed to reply satisfactorily, their recognition were cancelled by the Ministry of Education, it is learnt.

It may further be mentioned here that the Ministry of Education had cancelled the academic recognition to 511 educa-

tional institutions and of the 32 are in Khulna Division.

These Secondary Institutions are 9 in Bagerhat, 4 in each of Khulna and Meherpur, 3 in each of Jessore and Narail and 1 in each of Jhenidah, Magura, Satkhira and Kushtia districts.

The colleges are 3 in Khulna and 1 in each of Kushtia and Bagerhat districts.

According to Board source, these institutions were Shapla College in Terokhada, Batbunia College in Dakope, Lions School and College in Khalishpur in Khulna district, Khan Jahan Ali Mahila College in Bagerhat district and Hossainabad Higher

Secondary School of Daulatpur, Kushtia.

These secondary schools are Dhopakhalā Secondary School, Phultala, Katnia Ak. Secondary School, Koyra and Anandanagar Adarsha Secondary School, Rupsha in Khulna district, Kumarpur Girls School, Bagerhat Sadar, Jorabhatta Khamar Secondary School, Fakirhat, Betkhata School, Rampal, BC Bliasha High School, Kochua Baharbunia Secondary School, Morelganj Burburia School, Mongla, DN Ekota Girls School and Rajapur Secondary School, both in Swarankhola and Khostakata Union Secondary School, all in Bagerhat district.

Khalinagar Union Secondary School, Tala, Satkhira, Golegram, Notnapara Girls School, in Daulatpur, Kushtia, Modnadanga Girls' School in Meherpur Sadar, Boat Adarsha Girls School, HB Girls School and Jayati Secondary Girls' School, all in Gangni, Chuadanga, Hakimpur Girls School in Monirampur, Palli Ufnayan Girls School in Keshabpur, Komarpole Girls School in Keshabpur, all in Jessore district, Devipur High School in Narail Sadar, Khararia Girls School and Pallimangul School in Kalia, Narail, A Rakib Girls School in Jhenidah and Dalhara Paschimpara School of Magura district.
