## Take advantage to get children educated: Biswas

A 20-member delegation of Pura commissioners, imams and motawallis of mosques of Sagardi under Barisal Municipality called on President Abdur Rahman Biswas at Bangabhaban Tuesday, reports BSS.

Led by Pura Commissioner Shahabuddin Sardar, the members of the delegation apprised the President of some of the local problems including the necessity of improvement of roads, supply of pure drinking water and electricity and repair and reconstruction of mosques and madrasahs of the locality.
