## Revision of CU academic rules demanded

CHITTAGONG, Jan 22: - Students aggrieved by the newly announced academic rules at Chittagong University (CU) at a news conference urged the university management immediate amendment of the new rules.

They also announced agitation program including seat-in tomorrow in front of the university's administrative building demanding immediate amendment of the black rules for the greater interest of students.

The victim students held the press conference at the office of Chittagong University Journalist Association (CUJA) yesterday.

Several hundreds of the CU students could not appear at their supplementary and improvement exams as the university authority in the new academic rules said that the students would have to appear at their supplementary and improvement exams with the immediate next batch.

The new rules also said that there was no scope to appear at the exams if the students would not appear at the exam with the next academic session. Earlier, the students could appear at the supplementary and improvement exams with any of the next academic session until their final year exams.

The victim students claimed that the university authority had introduced the new academic rules without earlier issuing notices to the all department heads.
