

CMC dorms open today, classes from July 15

CHITTAGONG, July 13:—Dormitories of Chittagong Medical College (CMC) have been reopened today after a two-day closure.

Initially the CMC Academic Council closed the college sine die and asked resident students to vacate the dorms over fierce clashes between the workers of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS).

Later, the Academic Council after a series of meetings with the district administration, security people and student organizations withdrew the closure announcement and decided to reopen the dorms on Sunday (July 13).

Principal of the college Dr. MA Wahab told reporters that many of the students had already returned to the dorms on the opening day while the rest would return soon.

An official of the college said students entered their respective dorms and rooms after their identity and baggage checked by the dorm super. Students are not getting to the dorm before July 15 will require special permission from the college authority.

All examinations will take place according to the schedule given earlier while the lecture and practical sessions will take place as usual from July 15.
