

## DU Dean Election Aug 19

Twenty-one teachers, belonging to the pro-BNP-Jamaat (white panel) and pro-Awami League and left-leaning parties (blue panel) will vie in the upcoming election to the Dean's of Dhaka University (DU) scheduled to be held on August 19.

Only for ten-month, a total of 10 deans will be selected for 10 faculties through election will be held at the Teacher Students Centre (TSC) guestroom from 9.00am to 1.00pm on the day. DU treasurer Prof. Syed Abul Kalam Azad will conduct the election as the election commissioner.

The incumbent Dean of arts faculty Prof. Sadrul Amin from white panel and Prof. Fakhru Alam of the department of English from blue panel will contest for the post of dean of arts faculty. The incumbent dean of the social sciences faculty Prof. Harun-ur-Rashid will face Prof. Ferdous Hossain of the Department of political science for the post of the faculty.

Prof. Tazmeri SA Islam of the Department of Chemistry from white panel and Prof. Muhibur Rahman of the same department from blue panel running for the Dean of science faculty. Prof. Mizanur Rahman, of the Department of Marketing from white panel and Prof. Abbas Ali of Management department from blue panel is vying for the Dean of business studies faculty.

The incumbent dean of biological science faculty Prof. Anwar Hossain from blue panel will face white panel candidate Prof. Abul Bashar of the Department of Zoology for the Dean of the faculty.

Prof. Abdur Rashid of the Department of pharmaceutical chemistry from white panel and Prof. Farida Begum of the Department of clinical pharmacy and pharmacology from blue panel will vie for the position of the pharmacy faculty. Prof. Rafiqun Nabi from blue panel will have to face two opponents - Prof. Abdus Sattar and Prof. Mahmudul Haq, both from the white panel for the newly introduced fine arts faculty.

Prof. Shahnaj Haq Hussain of the Department of Geography from white panel will face the blue panel candidate Prof. Quamrul Hasan of Geology department for the position of earth and environmental science faculty. Prof. Shahida Rafique from white panel and Prof. Neem Chandra Bhowmik of the Department of applied physics from blue panel will contest for the position of the engineering and technology faculty.

Meanwhile, Prof. Jaban Uddin Khan has already been declared elected of law faculty dean unopposed. No other nomination papers was submitted for the elec-
