DU students urge to protect FFs quota

Students of Dhaka University (DU) on Tuesday brought out a procession on the campus demanding revision of the existing quota system in the Bangladesh Civil Service (BCS) jobs without harming the freedom fighters' allocation.

Students under the banner 'General Students' led by the activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), the students' wing of Awami League, burst into protests chanting various slogans against Shibir activists and de-

nounced the illogical strike enforced by them.

On Monday, agitating students who continued demonstration against the quota system for the last one month enforced a three-day strike at all public universities and university colleges in the country from February 26 to 28 demanding cancellation of the quota system.

They vowed that they would go for a tougher movement if their demand were not met by February
