## Court orders injunction on April 12 DUTA election

Dhaka Judge court on Thursday issued temporary injunction on Dhaka University Teachers' Association election scheduled for tomorrow (Saturday), reports UNB.

The order came from senior assistant judge Merina Sultana asking the authorities to refrain from holding polls of the teachers' association.

It came upon a petition of Shafiqul Islam, a student of the university. He submitted that there are every possibility of conflict and clashes between the

contesting parties endangering law and order situation.

The country is under the state of emergency. Hence, election with apprehension of trouble should be stopped forthwith.

Earlier on April 8 the court had ordered ad interim injunction on election and directed the defendants to explain why temporary injunction should not be imposed.

The defendants - the vice-chancellor, registrar, deputy commissioner and police commissioner - on Thursday appeared before the court through their counsel.

The court issued the temporary injunction on the election after hearing both sides.
