

2 technical training centres to be opened

Two technical training centres one in Thakurgaon and another in Dinajpur — will be opened soon. Manpower Development and Social Welfare Minister, Mr S.A. Bari A.T. said, in Dacca on Sunday, reports BSS.

Mr Bari was speaking last night at a reception accorded in his honour by the Dinajpur Samity in Dacca at the Teachers' Training College auditorium. Mr Ijabuddin Ahmed, President of the samity presided over the function.

Mr Bari said that the work for the proposed technical training centres will begin next month. He said the centres will help effectively utilise the unemployed youths of the two areas.

Pointing out the bright prospect of employment for the skilled and trained Bangladeshis in the Middle-Eastern countries, the Minister said his Ministry was preparing a 15-year plan in this regard. He also assured the members of the samity that he would pursue for expediting the setting up of a Medical College in Dinajpur.
