

University of Hull ushers opportunities for Bengali students

The University of Hull is offering scholarships to the Bangladeshi students who have applied for the September 2008 intake at the university.

Students having excellent academic qualification will be eligible for the scholarships for the September 2008 intake for different programmes. These included science and engineering M Sc programme, business school MBA and M Sc programmes, LL M and

Faculty of arts and social science.

This was disclosed at a news conference organised by Infozee study abroad, held at the National Press Club on Tuesday. Radhika Longbottom, International Recruitment Officer of the university said the variety of courses and qualification of the university give the students a chance to develop their career from school, or update existing skills. Anoop Patel, chairman of Infozee study abroad was present in the conference.

Radhika said at Hull, students will be parts of a cosmopolitan community in a creative and supportive environment and would settle in straight away. She said the Hull will create excellent part-time job opportunities for the students. The students would get excellent opportunities to gain work experience in the UK along with UK qualifications.
