

# DU JCD puts off today's strike plan

With assurance from Dhaka University (DU) administration of ensuring peaceful co-existence on the campus, Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), the student wing of JNP, on Saturday postponed their strike scheduled to be observed today (Sunday).

JCD called a strike on the campus sticking to its six-point demands including ensuring peaceful academic atmosphere and co-existence on the campus, legal action against the accused BCL activists who allegedly attacked JCD activists.

JCD leaders and some members of DU Teachers' Association (DUTA) held in a

meeting with DU Vice-chancellor Prof. AAMS Arefin Siddique and Proctorial Body of the university on Saturday. In the two-hour long meeting, the authorities assured the JCD leaders that they would take urgent steps to meet their demands and urged them to refrain from any agitation.

Meanwhile, at least three leaders of JCD were injured in an attack by the activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) on the campus on Saturday. The injured JCD leaders are Amiruzzaman Khan Shimul, assistant general secretary of JCD central unit, Md. Rasel Miah, organising secretary of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Hall and Biplob Pande Bipu, president of Jagannath Hall unit of JCD. They were rushed to the DMCH for treatment.

BCL central joint-secretary Jashim Uddin and DU unit president Sheikh Sohel Rana Tipu however blamed that internal feud in the JCD. He said that JCD is trying to destabilise the normal atmosphere of the campus.

Leaders and activists of BCL also brought out a procession on the campus in protest against the terrorist activities of JCD on the campus. The rally paraded different streets following a demonstration in front of Arts Building.

JCD leaders and activists also brought out a rally on the campus protesting the attack on JCD leaders by BCL activists. Later, they held a demonstration at the main gate of Arts Building. In the demonstration, JCD DU unit president Hasan Mamun disclosed the withdrawal of strike.
