

RU reopens after 82 days amid uncertainty

Police misbehaving with residential students

RAISHAHI UNIVERSITY, June 2:—After a long unscheduled vacation classes of Rajshahi University (RU) reopened the presence of huge numbers of law enforcer agencies.

Seeing the campus situation, anybody can realise easily the campus is only for the cops.

Hundreds of armed force

police are living in the guest rooms of 16 residential halls.

In the name of strict security police and hall guards misbehave with the resident students.

Some female students alleged "we feel embracing while male police check our personal parts several times on the campus."

At least 500 law enforcer agencies are deployed in various halls and dangerous points of Rajshahi University (RU) campus while the campus reopened after consuming 82 days unscheduled vacation yesterday.

The residential halls have already been opened for the students, but presence of general students is very poor.

The students are allowed to enter their room after checking their residential identity cards and luggage at every residential hall.

Sources alleged that, Islami Chattra Shibir (ICS) and Bangladesh Chattra League (BCL) are inflexible and in strict position till now to keep their supremacy at campus although all kinds of meeting,

postering, leaflet distribution and gathering are prohibited in the campus.

Both the student organizations are going on their showdown and creating panic situations among the students on the campus.

General students of the university still fear the activities BCL and ICS.

Sources alleged that students alleged that RU administration is trying to control the student organizations politically.

The authority didn't try to create congenial atmosphere on the campus.
