

BRUR teachers protest at conspiracies against public univs

TEACHERS of Begum Rok-
 eya University, Rangpur
 under the banner of Muk-
 tijuddher Chetona Pro-

 have strongly protested at

 on Saturday.

The speakers blamed
 vested quarters for hatching
 conspiracies against BRUR
 to destabilise its reputation,
 academic atmosphere and
 hinder massive develop-
 ment works as a part of their
 efforts like in some reputed
 public universities in recent
 times.

 university, BRUR has
 achieved huge successes in
 academic and infrastruc-
 tural development activities
 with government assistanc-
 es and initiatives of commit-
 ted young teachers under
 the leadership of the vice-
 chancellor, they said.
