

6 hurt in CU BCL infighting 3 arrested

SIX Bangladesh Chhatra League activists were injured in an infighting in Chittagong University centering on the control of the shuttle train on Saturday.

Three of the critically injured were admitted to Chittagong Medical College Hospital.

The police recovered sharp weapons, firearms and bullets and arrested three Chhatra League men. The arrested are Tusher, Mamun and Ovi. The police recovered the firearms from Tusher.

The police quoting witnesses said that the clash had begun about 9:00am at the university railway station and its adjoining areas between two groups of shuttle train commuters known as Sixty-Nine and Ekakar.

The police and university proctorial body rushed to the spot and dispersed the group members.

The university's assistant proctor AKM Ziaur Rahman Khan told New Age, 'We are trying to find out the people responsible for the incident. We will take disciplinary action against them.'

The university unit Chhatra League president, Mamunul Haque, said, 'We will take necessary steps against the accused activists.'

The authorities still have since 2009 a ban in place on political activities of all kinds on the campus.
