

Three injured in BCL factional clash at CU

THREE activists of the Chittagong University unit Bangladesh Chhatra League were injured in factional clash at Shah Jalal Hall on the campus early Sunday.

The injured are Sadil, 3rd year student of philosophy, Mohammed Rasel, 4th year student of management studies, and Sazzad, Master's student of history department.

The clash ensued between the two groups after they went to take shahri in the dining room of Shah Jalal Hall, witnesses said.

CU proctor Professor

Siraj Uddowla said the clash erupted as a sequel to a previous clash which took place on Saturday.

'We instantly deployed the law enforcement personnel on the campus to avert any untoward situation further,' added the proctor.

Mamunul Haque, president of CU unit BCL, denied the incident of clash and claimed that the injured did not belong to BCL.

Earlier, a factional clash took place between Mamun group and Abul Mansur group of the organisation in front of CUCSU, leaving one activist injured.
