

BCL leader expelled for addiction

RULING Awami League-backed student body Bangladesh Chhatra League on Friday expelled its central committee deputy secretary for science affairs Mustakin Murshed Limon from the organisation forever for his alleged drug addiction.

BCL general secretary Siddiqui Nazmul Alam told New Age they had expelled Limon for his involvement in anti-organisational activities.

'Being addicted and involved in extortion, Limon failed to carry on organisational activities. So we have expelled him,' he added.

The Chakbazar police on Thursday arrested Limon, also a student of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology, on an extortion case filed against him three months ago.

Officer-in-charge of the police station Mohammad Ali told New Age they had forwarded Limon to the court on Friday.

'We did not know he was an addict and mentally depressed,' Ali added.
