DU students to go for movement for DUCSU polls

DHAKA University students at a human chain on Sunday vowed to stage greater demonstrations unless the university authorities would hold elections to the central students' union.

The students, teamed up as Shiksharti Adhikar Mancha, formed the human chain at Aparajeya Bangla and said that they would hold a press conference on March 15 to announce their movement to push for elections to the Dhaka University Central Students' Union to 'establish student rights'.

They also said that the au-

thorities had collected fees every year from the students in name of DUCSU and hall unions but they had not held elections to the students' unions for 22 years.

The students at the rally said that the authorities were not holding the elections as they think that this may limit their supremacy on the campus.

Samima Akhtar Zahan of the physics department, Marshal Mahbub of the music department, Shiksharti Adhikar Mancha spokesman Mowdid Misty and some other students, addressed the human chain, attended by hundreds of students.
