

## Case filed against 19 DU BCL men for attempted murder

A DHAKA University student on Wednesday filed a case against 19 leader and activists of the university unit Chhatra League, including the unit's organising secretary, for attempted murder charges with a Dhaka court.

Md. Abbas Ali, a third-year student of Islamic studies, filed the case with the chief metropolitan magistrate's court.

Magistrate Md. Morujjaman ordered the Shahbag police officer-in-charge to register the matter as a regular case and investigate the matter. The court passed the order after hearing and recording the plaintiff's submission.

The plaintiff filed the case against the organising secretary Mohammad Anu and activists Md. Tuhin, Abdul Baten and AL Amin, among others.

In his complaint, Abbas Ali said that after his class, when he was going back to his house at Azimpur, a group of Chhatra League men, led by Anu, had attacked him with axe and other weapons on the campus on September 10.

The attackers snatched his mobile and money. Some students sent him to Dhaka Medical College Hospital and he was later admitted to Islami Bank Central Hospital at Kakrail.

The plaintiff did not mention his any political identity in his petition.
