

DSHE to install 32 CC cameras to 'curb corruption'

THE Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education will establish 32 closed-circuit cameras at different important points of its main building to lessen harassment of teachers who come to the directorate for various services, officials said.

'We have decided to install CC cameras in all important points to lessen harassment of teachers and to provide them with better services,' director general of the Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education Noman-ur Rashid told New Age on Saturday.

He said the process of in-

stallation was going on and they would be in operation soon.

There will be two control panels from where activities will be monitored.

Noman also said there would be also a help desk to help the teachers with information.

The directorate has a bad reputation for harassing teachers who come from different parts of the country for different purposes.

Many teachers have alleged that the employees and officials of the directorate demand bribe for transfer, Monthly Pay Order and other necessary problems of the teachers.
