

## 7 CUET students expelled

SEVEN students of Chittagong University of Engineering and Technology were expelled for different period as they were involved in recent clash on the campus.

Authorities issued a notice on Thursday saying that the punishment would be effected from November 11.

The CUET student welfare adviser, professor Asutosh Saha, confirmed the expulsion decision.

The expulsion decision came from the CUET disciplinary committee meeting held on December 3.

Among the students, Mobasserul Islam Pavel, 3rd year of urban and regional planning department,

Naimul Islam Mazumder, 2nd year of electrical and electronics engineering, Md Asifur Rahman Jibon, 4th year of computer science and engineering and Rafat Al Mehedri, 2nd year of computer science and engineering, were expelled for one year as they misbehaved with the teachers and injured the general students during the demonstration on the campus, said professor Asutosh Saha.

Syed Tasnim Hasan Rana, a 4th year student of computer science and engineering and NA Nahin, 3rd year of mechanical engineering, were expelled for six months as they involved in the incident.

Mahmudul Hasan Rasal, a 4th year student of electrical and electronics engi-

neering was also expelled on condition for six month as he allegedly led the general students' demonstration on the campus.

The students broke the university disciplines and rules and the committee found evidence against them, professor Asutosh Saha told New Age adding that on condition, the expelled students could appeal to the chairman of academic council within 15 days.

The CUET authorities shut down the campus and suspended all the academic activities from October 10 to November 12 following a demonstration of the students as a fellow of them was injured by Bangladesh Chhatra League activist on October 9.
