

Non-govt teachers want fest allowance before Eid

THE teachers and employees of non-government schools and colleges demanded that payment of their full festival allowance should be made before Eid-ul-Fitr instead of 25 per cent of their basic salary as per the promise made to them by the government last month.

They also expressed dissatisfaction at non-implementation of the pledges made to them by the government during their agitation in the capital in May-June. The reiteration of the demands and the expression of the dismay came at a meeting jointly organised by Bangladesh Shikshak Samity and Shikshak-Karmachari Sangram Oikya Parishad, held at the temporary office of the Samity at Purana Pallan in the city on Monday.

Chaired by Nazrul Islam Ronny, central president of Bangladesh Shikshak Samity and chief coordinator of Shikshak-Karmachari Sangram Oikya Parishad, the meeting was addressed among others, by Sajeda Begum, chief adviser of the Samity, Md Riaz Uddin, acting secretary general of the Samity and Md Jasim Uddin, president of Dhaka city unit of the Samity.
