# Non-govt teachers hold rally to press for 17-pt demand

They criticised the government for giving them Tk 150 as house rent and Tk 100 as medical allowance.

Teachers and employees of non-government high schools and colleges of the district yesterday brought out a procession and held a rally in the town to press

for their 17-point demand including nationalisation of the education system.
