

'Shibir men' cut tendons of BCL activist

Alleged Shibir men yesterday cut the tendons of a Chhātra League activist at Lalbagh in Rangpur yesterday.

The victim is Mosharraf Hossain, 25, organising secretary of the BCL unit at Rangpur Carmichael College. He was admitted to the Rangpur Medical College Hospital in a critical condition.

Police and witnesses said six to seven masked men hacked Mosharraf with sharp weapons and severed the tendons of his both legs and the right hand. The incident happened around 3:00pm.

when he was returning to his mess on the College Road.

Doctors at the RMCH operated on him but he was still in a critical condition, said RMCH acting principal Nurunnabi Laizu.

Later in the evening, Mosharaf was referred to the National Institute of Traumatology, Orthopaedics and Rehabilitation in the capital after his condition worsened.

Shahabuddin Khalifa, officer-in-charge of Rangpur Kotwali Police Station, said they were trying to catch the attackers.

Rafiur Rahman Rafi, president of the college BCL unit, said Shibir men tried to kill Mosharraf to establish their supremacy on the campus.

But the city unit Shibir president dismissed the claim.

"Mosharraf was injured in a factional clash over establishing supremacy on the campus," he added.
