

**DEMAND FOR REMOVAL  
JU VC starts  
sit-in against  
teachers' demo**

Jahangirnagar University Vice Chancellor Prof Anwar Hossain started a sit-in in front of his official residence on the campus Tuesday night to counter a fresh round of protest by some teachers demanding his removal.

Prof Anwar said he, along with his wife Ayesha Akter, would continue the protest until the teachers withdrew their sit-in from near his residence, which began earlier on Tuesday.

Under the banner of Sadharon Shikshak Forum, the teachers resumed their demonstrations after a month as the VC did not quit by Monday.

Meanwhile, some agitating teachers have confined Registrar Abu Bakar Siddique and Deputy Registrar Abu Hasan to their offices since Monday protesting appointments of three deans to the faculties of law, business administration, and biological science.

The protesters said the VC could not recruit the three as an investigation was underway against him. The confinement was aimed at barring the registrar from signing the appointment letters.

Protesting the confinement of the registrar, JU Employee's Association staged a rally yesterday and went on work abstention for an indefinite period.

Some pro-VC teachers and a group of Bangladesh Chhatra League activists of its JU unit under the banner of Jahangirnagar University Poribar formed a human chain and brought out a procession condemning the ongoing anti-VC movement by some teachers.

Sadharon Shikshak Forum has been staging demonstrations intermittently since April 27 accusing Prof Anwar of failing to expel a BCL leader for assaulting a teacher, committing irregularities in teachers' recruitment, and misusing university funds.
